### **About the Role**

The Backend/Web team is responsible for developing and maintaining the backend system for our patient facing mobile apps and the full stack of internal and client facing web apps. These HIPAA compliant systems process both medical records and sensitive data while facilitating care and communication between patients using our mobile applications and Healthcare Advocates and Providers using our web applications.

Our service architecture is TypeScript/Node.js running in Kubernetes hosted by AWS (EKS), serving Apollo GraphQL APIs. We use MongoDB Atlas and Confluent Kafka for primary data storage and stream processing. The web apps are TypeScript/React (17) using Material UI components and Apollo Client state management. Our primary observability system is Newrelic, and our CI/CD pipeline is a mix of Jenkins and GitHub Actions.

The team is a blend of US based full time Wildflower employees and contractors from our partner firm in eastern Europe. We work as an integrated team, meeting each workday (at 8:00 AM PDT / 7:30 AM PST) to plan, discuss, and demo our



tasks. Wildflower is a small growing company, the team is responsible for designing, coding, testing, deploying, monitoring, and administering our projects. Due to contractual requirement, only the US engineers are authorized to interact with the production environment. We do not have a formal on-call schedule, but engineers are expected to help in rare cases of off-hours system failures.

Candidate must reside and work in the United States.

### **Ideal Candidate**

- Strong TypeScript/JavaScript experience.
- Familiarity with the technologies listed above.
- Ability to flesh out the technical details from feature requirements and present the different implementation options to team for feedback.
- Good online communication skills.
- Independent work ethic, hitting deliverables while coordinating with a team across different time zones.
- Able to constructively provide and receive feedback in a code review, one on one, or group setting.
- Information security awareness, and experience handling sensitive information.
- Experience administering/debugging production systems.
